

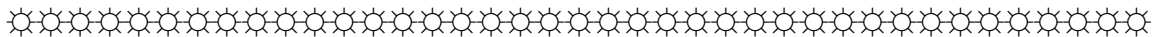


The AAACEI Delaware Valley Section Presents
