“Update on RP29”

Mark your calendars now for May 12, 2010

Mark Nagata and Mark Sanders will discuss recent developments surrounding the RP, including the public debate at the ABA’s Forum on the Construction Industry, the recent PMI-COS Town Hall Meetings and the current development of Revision 2 that is scheduled for publication in October 2010.

Mark Nagata and Mark Sanders will discuss on the key points listed below:

- ✚ AACE International’s Recommended Practice on Forensic Schedule Analysis (RP29) has generated a tremendous amount of discussion in both the engineering and construction community and the legal community since it was first published in June 2007.
- ✚ The RP has been the subject of presentations at the Construction Superconference, the PMI College of Scheduling Conference, the ABA Forum on the Construction Industry and AACEI’s Annual Meetings over the past three years.
- ✚ The RP has also been the subject of two articles in *The Construction Lawyer*: the first by critics of the RP in October 2009, and the second by authors of the RP in January 2010

Mark Nagata and Mark Sanders are co-authors of RP29 and have been working diligently on the task force since its inception in June 2003. They are also the co-directors of the PMI College of Scheduling’s Best Practices and Guidelines for Schedule Impact Analysis. In both roles, they have continued to encourage discussion and debate over the various approaches and methods taken by contractors, construction managers and experts seeking to analyze schedule impacts.
